

### Meal Benefits Research Study

Meals that Matter: How Food Benefits Can Help Recruit, Retain, and Return Employees to the Office

#### Introduction

In partnership with leading research firm Wakefield Research, we set out to understand how office professionals think about lunch breaks and food benefits provided by their companies.

The Sharebite Survey was conducted by Wakefield Research (www. wakefieldresearch.com) among 500 US office professionals at companies with a minimum of 200 employees, between September 21st and September 28th, 2022, using an email invitation and an online survey. Oversample interviews were conducted to increase the total sample size to 100 per industry in the following industries: financial services, technology, professional services. The data was weighted.





It all boils down to this:

A lunch break and provided food not only makes employees feel healthier and happier, but also improves their work performance and productivity.

Lunch breaks have a measurable, positive impact. 97% of office professionals say taking a lunch break improves their workday.

Meals are a huge draw back to the office.

14% of respondents never take lunch breaks and 1 in 5 respondents take breaks 2 days or less.

61% are at least somewhat likely to switch companies for comparable jobs with free meals.







# Which perk would you prefer to receive from your employer?



Free meals 5 times per week from the restaurant of your choice


1 in 3 employees would rather have free meals than extra days off.








## How, if at all, does taking a lunch break improve your work day?






How likely would you be to leave your current company for a comparable job & salary at a different company that offers free meals?






Which of the following, if any, are reasons why you don't take lunch breaks during work?






## Influence of free meals on going into the office\*

\*Among those whose company doesn't already offer free meals






On average, how many days per week do you take at least a 20-minute break from work to eat a meal?

**TOP TWO RANKED RESPONSES** 






If your company offered you all the benefits listed below, which would you use most often?

**TOP THREE RANKED RESPONSES** 






How important is it for you to work for a company that includes a social good component to the business, such as donating, giving back to the community, helping underprivileged groups, etc.?


